#### Kiddushim

- Families planning to celebrate a simcha in the minyan are encouraged to sponsor a minyan kiddush to follow services. Procedure to plan a simcha should include phone calls to the following at least two weeks prior:
  - 1. Lida Baker: to calendar the event
  - Lida Baker: to find out who the gabbi is for the day; then call the gabbai to plan aliyot, etc.
  - 3. Judy Weinstock: to coordinate and budget the kiddush
- Minyan treasurer is collecting donations to help pay for non-sponsored kiddishim, in addition to the once-a-month that the shul pays for. When sufficent funds are collected, a series of Minyan kiddusim will be scheduled.

#### Children on the bimah

#### Standards of dress

- Those who come to the minyan for Shabbos, haggim and yom tovim should have sensitivity of appropriate attire, to reflect a view of "fineness", that there is a longstanding Jewish minhag of "dressing up" for services, and that most members of the minyan prefer to see this minhag maintained.
- Ritual dress for women called for aliyot and for shaliach tzibbur: matter is refered to ritual committee to recommend a policy for review at next Steering Committee meeting.

## Minyan role in fund-raising for Temple Beth Am budget needs

- Annual dinner dance is not a "draw" for most minyan members
- Barry Rosenblatt will initiate a Minyan ways and means subcommittee to recommend an annual fund-raising event to stimulate minyan participation, and report back to next Steering Committee meeting.
